The Cub Scout Olympics Campout event will be run following the "Rules of Safe Scouting". All unit leaders must be Youth Protection trained, and all adults attending should be familiar with and agree to follow the guidelines set forth in the "Guide to Safe Scouting".

The Family Campout is staffed and run completely by volunteers. Issues or complaints shall be directed to the camp director. These types of events do not happen without a great deal of time and effort by youth and adult volunteers, please be respectful and show your appreciation to them.

Please register as soon as you can. You can register on-line, by mail or at the council office. Cancellations and refunds will be handled following the Blue Grass Council refund policy.

- Pylon obstacle run (time event)
- 50 yard dash (timed event)
- Basketball (most free throws in a row)


Things to know:

- Registration will begin at 4:00 p.m. on Friday until 8:00 p.m. The sites will be assigned of a first come/first served basis. Saturday morning registration will be from 8:00 a.m. 9:30 a.m.
- No vehicles are allowed in the campsites.
- Families/Scouts must bring their own camping gear. They are also responsible for their own meals.
- There can be no ground fires; above ground fire pits/barrels/grill will be permitted.
- No gas generators allowed.
- There will be potable water available on site.
- There will be porta-potties available for campers.
- No pets are allowed.
- No open toed shoes are allowed in camp.
- This is a rain or shine event. As well quoted in other leader guides: "Weather will be provided". The weather during this time of year can vary from sunny and hot, to cold and rainy usually within minutes of each other. Participants are encouraged to be prepared and should bring appropriate clothing."
- Volunteer staff will not be charged a registration fee. This applies to all volunteers who have coordinated with the Event Director prior to the event.
- Lost and found: There will be a lost and found at the Pavilion/Registration area. The camp staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items. At the close of the event, all unclaimed items will be disposed of.
- Uniforms: All youth and adult members of BSA are to be in proper uniform as required. The field uniform (Class A) is to be worn for the Friday Night Campfire, the Saturday morning Flag Ceremony, and the Saturday evening closing ceremony. Activity uniform can be worn at all other times.
- Prizes: There will be prizes awarded for the First Place winners in each event. There will be an award to the Tiger, Wolf, Bear and Webelos with the winning time/distance in each of the eight events.
- In addition to the eight events list later in this guide, it is anticipated that there will be a shooting range set up by the District/Council cub shooting sports staff.
