- Pre-registration must be turned in with payment, at the Scout office by Monday, April 7th. **No on-site registrations or payments will be accepted.**
- **Units will be allowed to DROP gear and/or a trailer at campsites but will be required to park in designated areas.**
- **Units will be responsible for food and cooking equipment, tents, sleeping gear, personal items, and dining flies or other equipment as you choose.** You **MUST** bring your own tent. Camp policy, **DO NOT** bring in firewood. Water will be available at campsites.
- Plan camp activities so that the Scouts complete advancement: pitching tents, planning menus, cooking, duty roster lists.
- Cook as a patrol using simple menus. Keep Saturday's lunch quick and simple (soup, chili, sandwiches).
- There will be a "Scouts' Own" religious service on Sunday.
